Casey Elementary School 8:45 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Support needy families by working alongside other volunteers in the NUTS (Neat Used Things for Sale) Store sorting books and/or sorting and hanging clothes, or help out with gardening in above-ground boxes. Wear close-toed shoes – tennis shoes are fine – and clothes you don't mind getting dirty. Minimum age is 10. Meet in Covenant's back parking lot at 8:30 a.m. to caravan to the warehouse.

Stewpot Community Services 8:30 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Organize Stewpot's clothing closet and restock its food pantry, or possibly work at the Opportunity Center, a day shelter for Jackson's homeless that provides help ranging from assistance with job searches to a place to wash their clothes. Wear comfortable clothes according to the weather. Meet in Covenant's back parking lot at 8:45 a.m. to caravan downtown.
